COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

FOUNDATIONAL COURSES

Christian Basics I

Whether you are new to the Christian faith or in need of a refresher, this course presents the basics clear in life application manner.

Christian Character I

How does a Christian behave? What is the character of a Christian? This course helps answer these questions with an emphasis on developing the fruit of the Spirit.

Christian Character II

Students will study the book of Colossians, which presents the absolute supremacy and authority of Jesus Christ in all things—the family, the church, the workplace and all creation.

GENERAL THEOLOGY

I, II, III John and Jude

This course will explore God's love and fellowship among the brethren and how to detect false teachings.

Book of Galatians

You will learn the freedom in which Christ has given His life to obtain. We will explore these freedoms so as not to be entangled again with the yoke of bondage.

Book of Ephesians

This course will help you look into eternity past and understand the mind of God for the church, which is Christ's body. It also instructs us how to fulfill God's will in our individual lives.

Book of Acts

A study of the workings of the Holy Spirit in the first century church.

Book of Genesis

The beginnings of all things – man, family, sin, Satan, life, death, and confusion.

Book of Hebrews

A clear, concise study of both ministry of Christ and the work of faith.

Book of John

In the book of John, Jesus is portrayed as the Son of God. The Gospel of John seeks to provide the student with basic facts of Jesus' deity.

Book of Romans

The contrast between law and grace is examined in this course.

EVANGELICAL TEACHING ASSOCIATION (E.T.A.)

Apologetics – This course is designed to teach methods of defending the believers' faith.

Prerequisite: Foundational Certificate

Church History – Focuses on the history of the early church. We will examine the reformation movement and the creation of denominational beliefs.

Personal Evangelism I – An examination of the Great Commission and how the believer is to respond to Christ's challenge.

Leadership Development, Part 2 – Becoming an effective leader is a process. This course will explore the meaning, commitment and development of a leader. Participants will be challenged to examine their leadership style in view of God's Word

Prerequisite: Part I and be a Ministry Team Leader or Assistant

How to Fast and Pray

Learn how fasting can strengthen your faith. Isaiah 58 will be examined to learn the why and how of fasting.
